# Century Road Club Association Records 1903–2003

A Finding Aid / December 2009 (updated December 2015)

### **Abstract**

Records of the Century Road Club Association, a bicycle racing club based in New York City, including correspondence, newsletters, minutes, photographs, race publicity and results, magazine and newspaper clippings, and other materials from approximately 1906 into 2003, documenting club activities and bicycle racing in the United States, particularly in the New York Metropolitan Area.

# **Background**

The Century Road Club Association (CRCA) is a bicycle racing club based in New York City. CRCA was founded in 1898, when it broke off from Century Road Club of America, a nationwide club based at that time in Chicago. For some time, the club consisted of several regional divisions as far away as Southern California, though the most active division was in New York.

The club's history tells much about the history of cycling in the New York Metropolitan Area, and in the United States in general. It served as a founding member of the Amateur Bicycle League of America (now USA Cycling) in 1920. Cyclists introduced to the sport through CRCA have participated in races at all levels of the sport nationally and internationally. In addition, up to the 1970s and early 1980s, leaders of the club played active roles in the administration of bicycle racing nationwide, such as in helping organization of championship events and managing U.S. teams in international competition.

For much of the period encompassed in this collection, the club was led by Lou Maltese, a top racer in the 1920s and 1930s. To an extent, this collection also serves as a documentary biography of Mr. Maltese.

### **Scope and Content**

This collection consists of records of the Century Road Club Association (CRCA), a bicycle racing club based in New York City, including correspondence, newsletters, minutes, membership cards and lists, financial records, photographs and slides, race

schedules, results, racing programs and fliers, cycling magazine and newspaper clippings, and other material from approximately 1906 to 2003. Among the material are documents from other cycling clubs in the Greater New York City Area, including the Century Road Club of America, the Kissena Cycling Club, and the Union Sportive Italian.

The collection as contains information concerning the creation of the Amateur Bicycle League of America (now USA Cycling) and about six-day and long distance bicycle racing, as well as racing at a wide range of locations in New York City and surrounding areas.

The collection contains much material about, produced by, or collected by Lou Maltese, a prominent racer in the 1920s and 1930s who became a leader in the club. Also included is correspondence about and from Jack Heid, who represented the United States in international competition beginning in the 1940s. In addition, it includes information about the organization of national championship races and the selection and management of United States teams in international cycling competitions.

# **Acquisition Information**

This material was accumulated in the course of business by officers and volunteers of CRCA. About half the collection (Set 1)was provided by Lou Maltese to another CRCA officer, Jim Boyd in the 1980s. Jim Boyd passed the material to CRCA officer Mike Green around 2007. Another part (Set 2) was passed from Lou Maltese to Betsy and Philip Jordan and then to CRCA officer Liz Marcello around 2014.

Eight packets containing a total of approximately 2,000 record cards. Most cards contain address and phone information, many have age, date of birth and/or date of death, member number (year member first joined CRCA and then sequential entry, e.g. "82-30") and notes or stamps of years for which membership was paid. Some indicate "life member" or have other notes, perhaps on race ("black"). Some indicate families, listing several people on one card. Arrangement within each packet alphabetical by last name, though unorganized within each letter. Packet 5-5 contains numerous cards of press and cycling industry contacts. Packet 5-8 is especially disorganized and contains some death/funeral cards.
