Paper Prototyping Analysis

Process

We performed 6 paper prototype tests using two drafts of the site. Our first version was with an information architecture professor, an architect and a kindergarten teacher. Using the feedback from the first round of testing we adapted our paper prototype and ran tests with a university educator, someone with a background in business and theater and a manager of a network for social innovators. We described what the different colors on our prototype represented, told them to approach it as though it were an actual website and ran through a series of tasks. We changed the order of the tasks as the order they were completed in changed the users familiarity with the site.

Also wanted to know what site is about and would click on About the Index link to learn about how is behind it, how it works, what funding it has, etc

Analysis & Conclusions

Through our first round of testing, several design flaws became immediately apparent. The major issues were as follows:

- "Learn" as a category
- The layout of the center of the homepage.
- Labeling & grouping of "the outliers": events, about design science, resources
- o The "collaborate" category was unclear to users

Using this feedback, we made the following changes for the second group of testers:

- We removed "Learn" all together and put its contents in other places throughout the site that made sense based on test results.
- Our second draft featured two big buttons on homepage rather than four. One large button, "Explore the Ideas," and the other smaller, "Discover the Challenge." This leads people right into the Index as readers/explorers, or into the Challenge as participants, re-enforcing the two-part nature of the site.
- We put each of "the outliers" in a static location on either the top or bottom of every page.
- Using "Discuss" rather than "Collaborate" added clarity to the purpose of the Groups.
- A search bar was added at the top of the page.

With these adaptations, our design tested much better. There was little to no confusion in executing the tasks. Our final design required few changes from this second draft.
